

Expectations for Your Magical Stay at Dunkley's 2026

-Parents, please read, sign below and return

Dunkley's Camp strives to offer each child "the Best Week of her/his Summer"... and one that is a positive and safe camp experience! It is essential for you to communicate to your child that violence, bullying, possession of weapons, profanity, disrespect, inappropriate sexual behavior, drug/alcohol use, smoking or any other behaviors that are potentially harmful to themselves or others will not be tolerated. Campers who can't live within these policies of camp or who are adversely affecting the experiences of other children will be dismissed. **If a child is dismissed from camp, no refund is given, and parents are required to make arrangements for immediate pick up. Dunkley's has a "Zero Tolerance Policy" for inappropriate behavior.**

Behavior and Safety Rules:

1. Respect the Camp and Others.
 - a. Bullying, harassing or unsafe behaviors will not be tolerated.
 - b. All campers will feel safe and supported at Dunkley's.
 - c. Rudeness or profanity to campers or staff will not be tolerated.
 - d. Graffiti or damage to Camp property is not permitted, and intentional property damage will be billed to campers.
2. Weapons of any kind are not permitted in camp.
3. Tobacco products (including vaping products) are not permitted in camp.
4. Alcohol/drugs are not permitted in camp.
5. Lighters, matches and candles are not permitted in camp.

Camp Policies:

1. Campers are only allowed on equipment with a coach present.
2. Campers are only allowed at the waterfront with a lifeguard present.
3. Life jackets must be securely fastened prior to using any boat, going tubing, skiing, sailing or kayaking.
4. Campers must remain on Dunkley's Camp property.
5. Cabins must be cleaned and beds made before warm ups.
6. Food and beverages are only allowed in the dining room or outside.
7. Gum is not permitted in camp.

Personal Property:

Dunkley's is not responsible for personal items lost at camp; please check the lost & found prior to departure.

1. Please label all clothing with your camper's name. Cameras must be labeled and left in the office at check in. Cameras are not allowed in bunks.
2. Weekend Campers can leave their cell phones in the office for use when out of camp on the weekends.
3. All other electronics (including apple watches with data plans) are not permitted in camp.
4. **Weekend Campers should bring \$30 for laundry (movies/mini golf or bowling.) This should be turned over to the "camp bank" on check in. Money is not permitted in cabins.**

Staying Healthy Expectations:

1. Remain at a respectful distance whenever possible.
2. Use hand sanitizer when entering any area, and wash your hands frequently.
3. Keep your windows and doors open, with fans on in bunks/cabin.

Be respectful and ask questions if you don't understand a policy. Please see Ruth, Dan, Katie or Jen if you don't feel heard or have any additional concerns.
